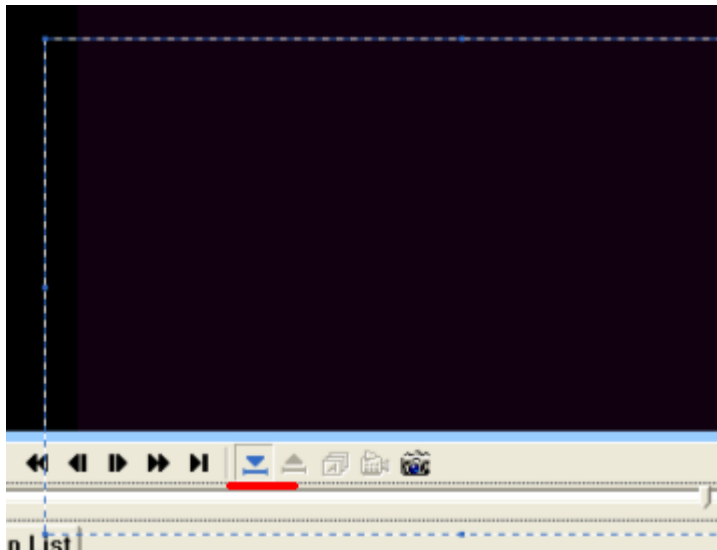


# 16 Steps to Make Your Video

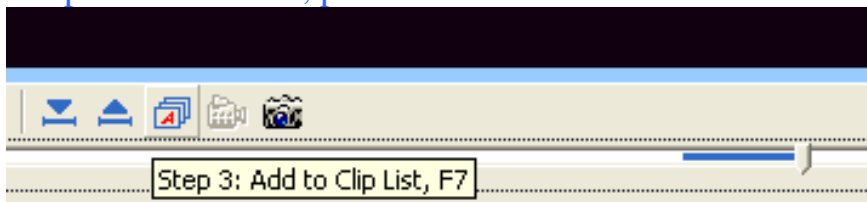
Step 1. Open the movie:



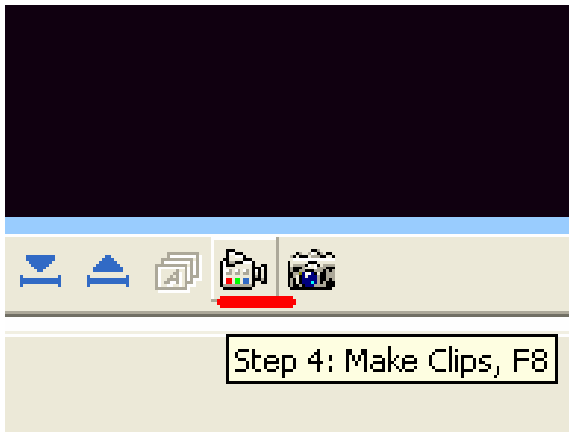
To start cutting the clip, press this button and to end the clip, press the button next to it.



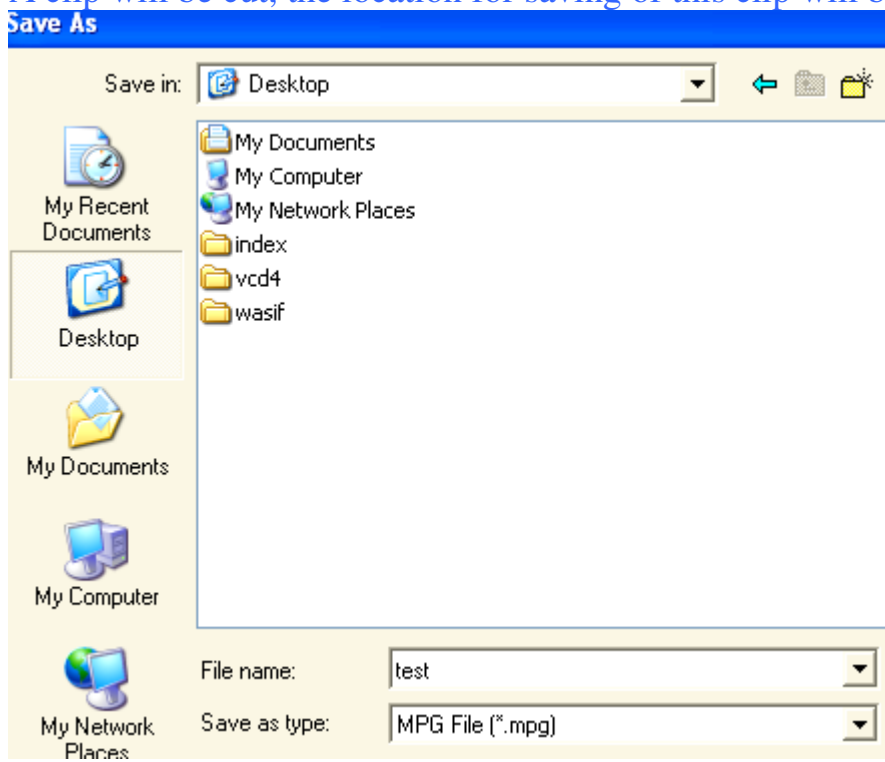
Step 3: When done, press A Button



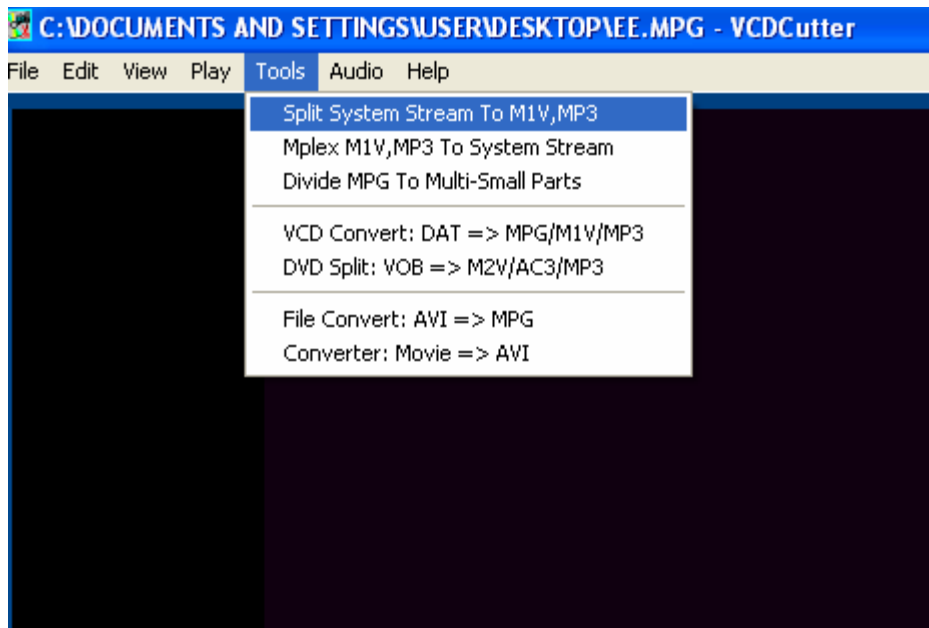
Step 4: Now press the video camera type button



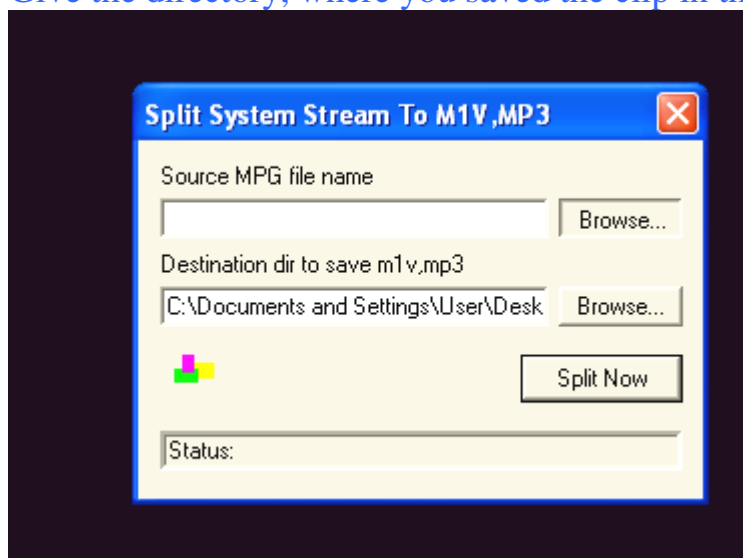
A clip will be cut, the location for saving of this clip will be asked



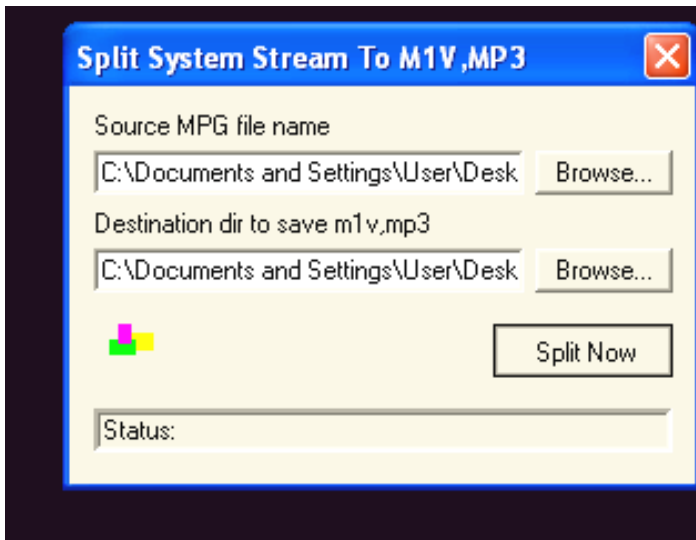
Step 5: Now go to “Tools” and select Split to M1v, and Mp3:



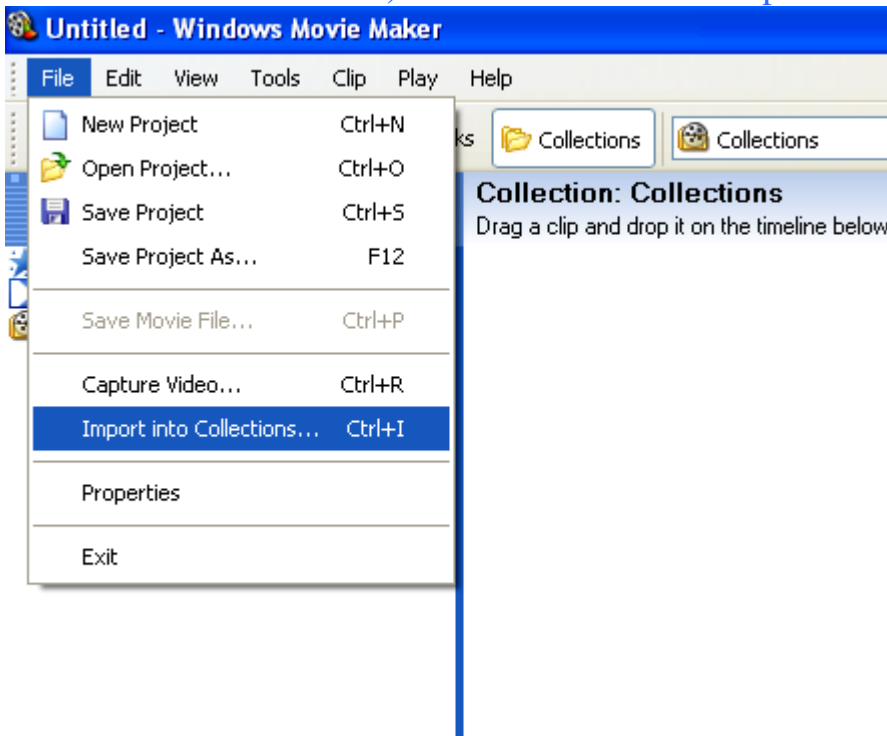
Give the directory, where you saved the clip in the first tab.



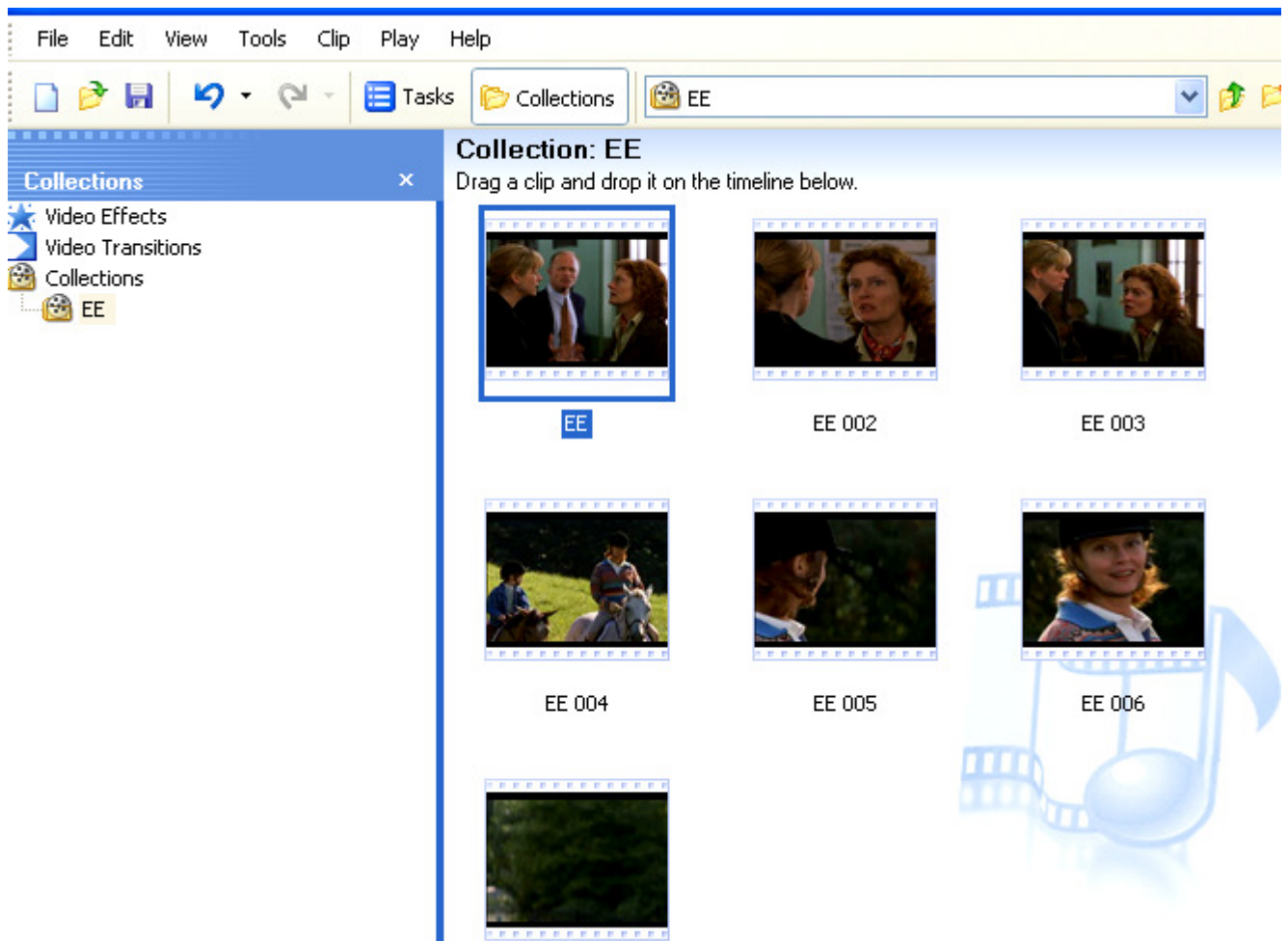
Step 6: Now press Split now button and Mpeg file will be split into separate Mp3 and M1v file.



Step 7: Now save M1V files only. Open Windows Movie Maker (not available on Windows 98) and in “File” select “Import into collections”




Step 8: Import all the M1v clips, they will appear like this.



Step 9: Click and drag clips as you want them to appear in the video into the panel below

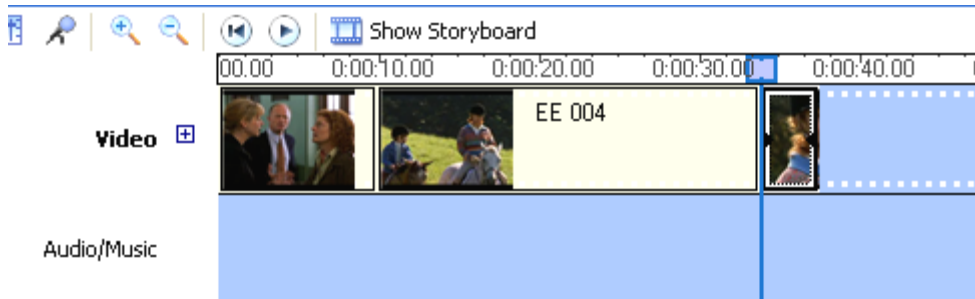

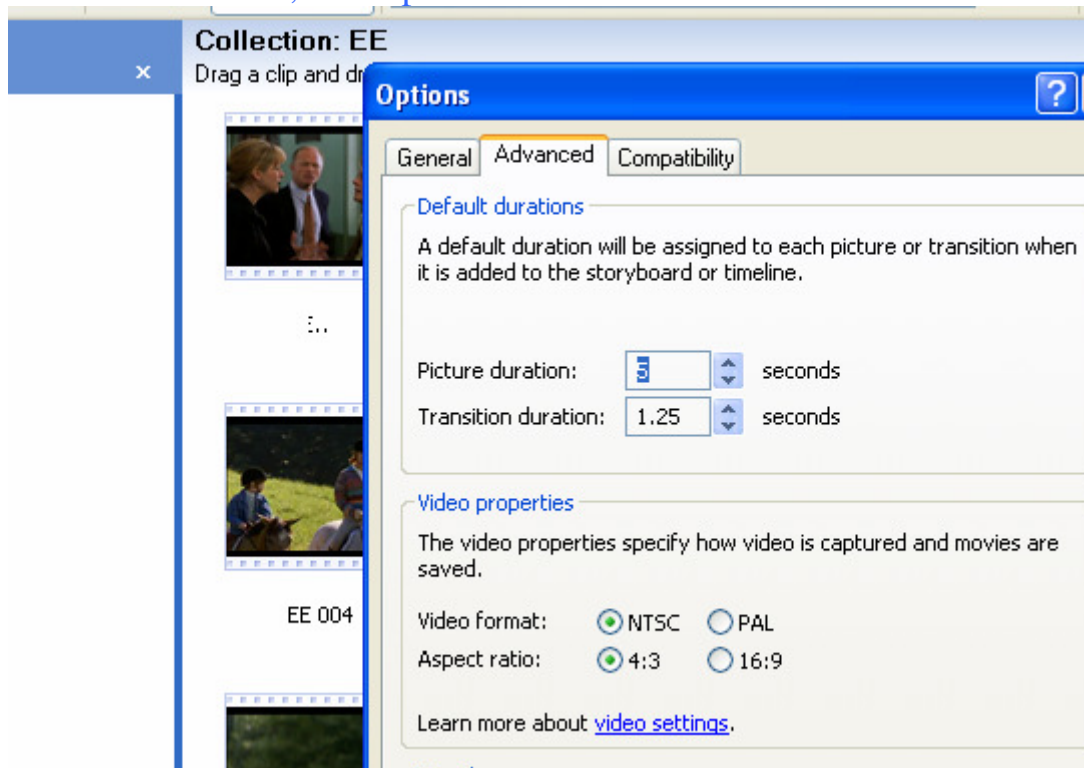

Music + Drag a video clip to the timeline to begin making a movie.

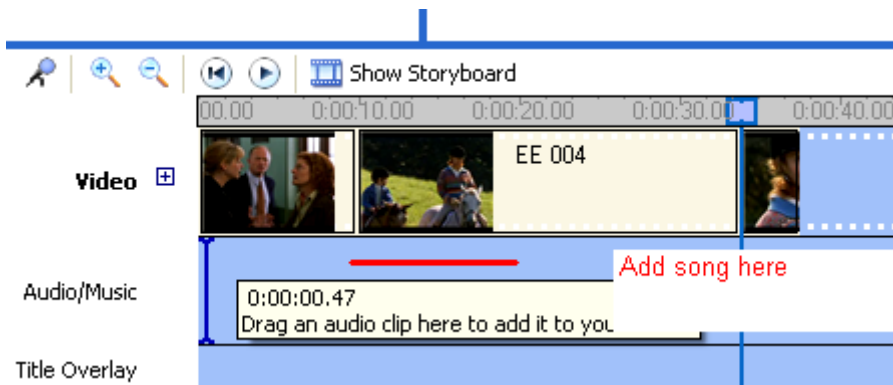


Step 10: Adding pictures in the video clips is simple. Simply import pictures and put in between the video clips, you can control the time limit you want the pictures to appear in the video by going to “Tools” and then “Options”. In “Advanced” tab, select picture duration.



Step 11: Adding song , go to file, “Import into collections” and select the song (Mp3 or WMA format) usually work. The song will appear into collections.

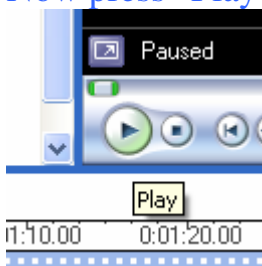

Step 12: Previewing your video:  
Press CTRL+A, Everything on the story board will be selected.

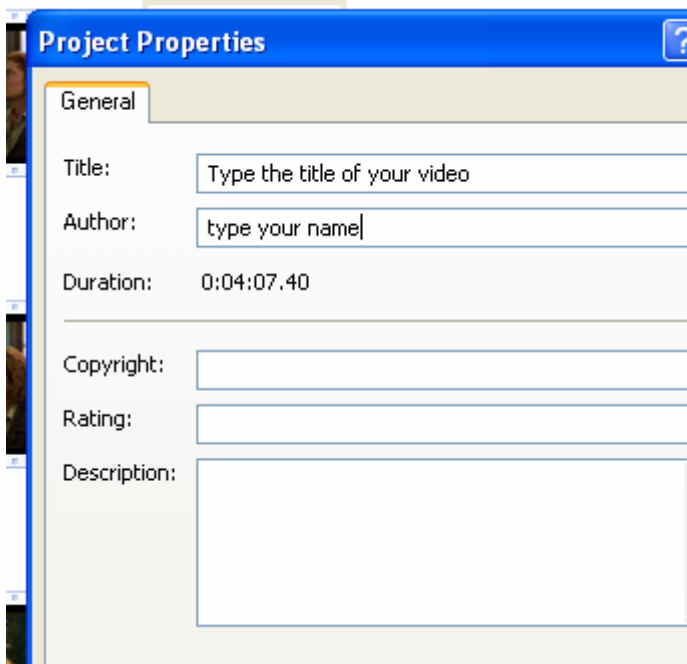


Now press "Play" button

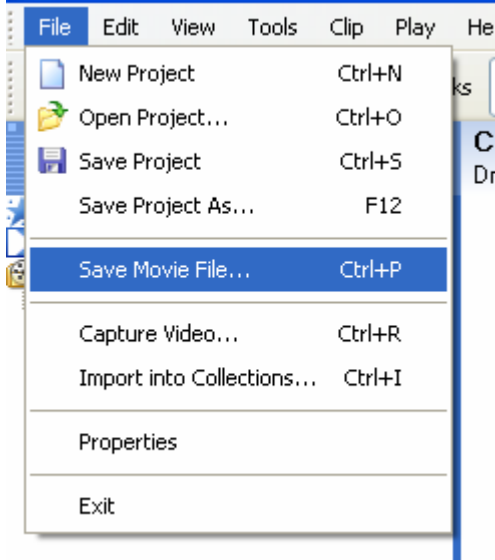


Step 13: Adding information to your video: Go to "File" and click "Properties". A box will appear, add the title of your video and your name.





Step 14: Saving it...Go to “File” menu and select “Save Movie file”



Step 15: The size and quality of video: You will be asked about saving the video according to different sizes. You may select a high size with best resolution or low size producing very poor quality if you want to send the clip in email to your friends.
